Gorenjska region


- 18 local communities
- 200.000 inhabitants
- Over 50 % of Natura 2000
- Valleys with 5 smaller cities
- sourunding hilly and mountain areas



Gorenjska region

- 50 % of forests
- 25 % of arrable land
- Settlements 25 %





Our situation -environmental risks and demographic change

- No real consensus about climate change
- No real consensus about influence of climate change in rural areas, its economic, social and environmental vibe
- Tramendous spatial pressure (no consensus about long term "stop" to spreading of urban sprawls
- Very sensitive environment climate risks (floods, avalances, fires, change in farming and other production/services)
- Lack of knowledge in the field of climate change
- Lack of consensual policy regarding climate change

Environmental risks

- Extreme weather a lot of rain in short time(floods, storms, ...)
- Extreme unexpected temperatures (drought)
- Extreme change in environment new deseases -trees, cultural plants,...

- Usage of natural materials
- Sustainable green tourism
- Prevention of damaging influence on environment
- Land usage need for regreening, stop to further urbanisation outside the existing settlements
